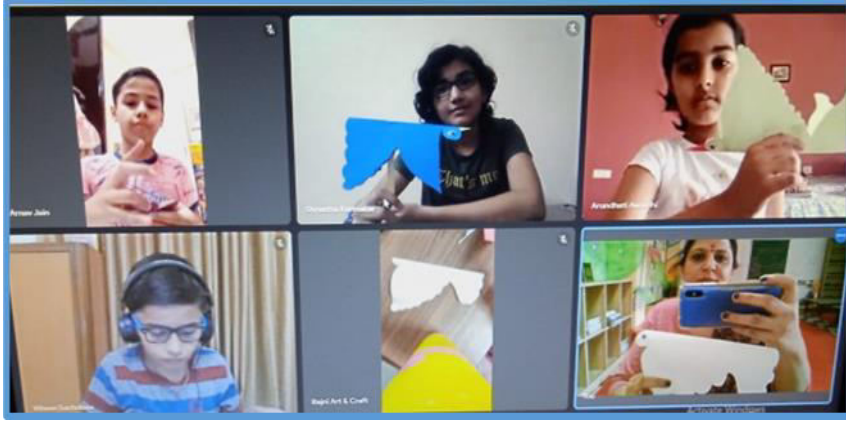
## ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY THEME : CREATIVE FEST (OCTOBER - 2021)



With an intent to give learners an insight about the Indian traditional art forms, a creative fest was organized for the learners of Mount Olympus School

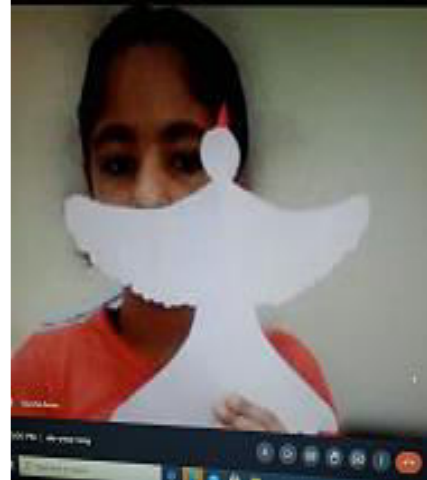
A workshop was conducted which included handloom, blue pottery, Lippan art, Bastar art, phulkari, Madhubani and much more.

**Bhagat Singh**



Bhagat Singh was born in Punjab, India (now Pakistan), on September 27, 1907, in a Sikh family deeply involved in political activities. He quit school at thirteen to devote his life to Indian independence. He became involved in several violent demonstrations of political defiance and was arrested several times. Singh was found guilty of killing a British police officer and hanged on March 23, 1931.



Patriotism means a noble sentiment of love, pride and sacrifice for the sake of one's country and its people. Keeping this spirit high, learners of Mount Olympus School celebrated Independence Day in their own unique and colorful way.

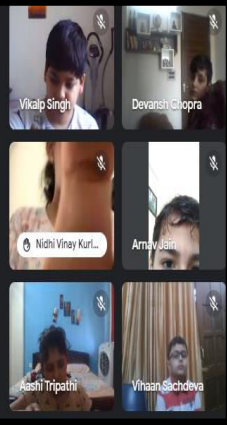

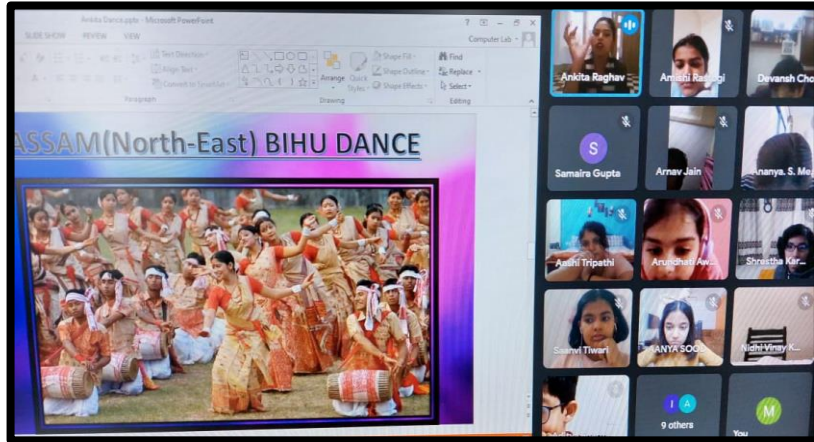
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# ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY

## THEME : "DANCE FEST"

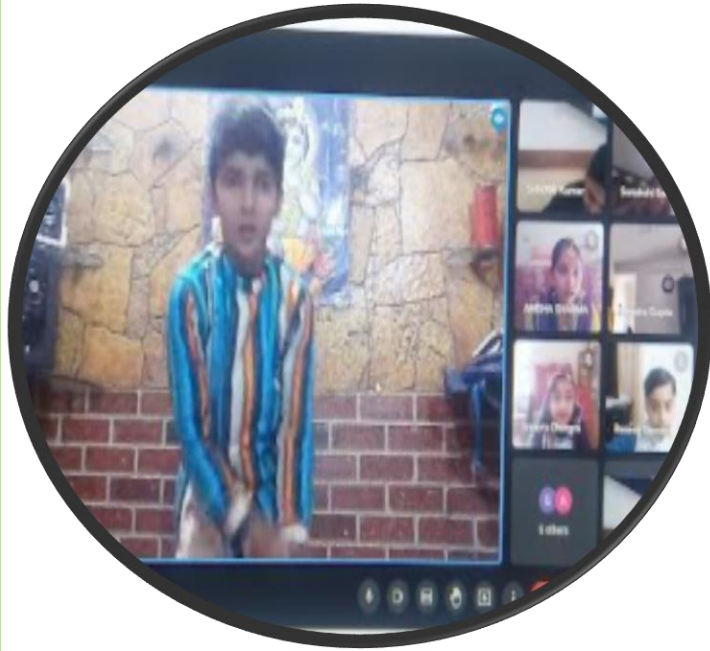
### (DECEMBER - 2021)
